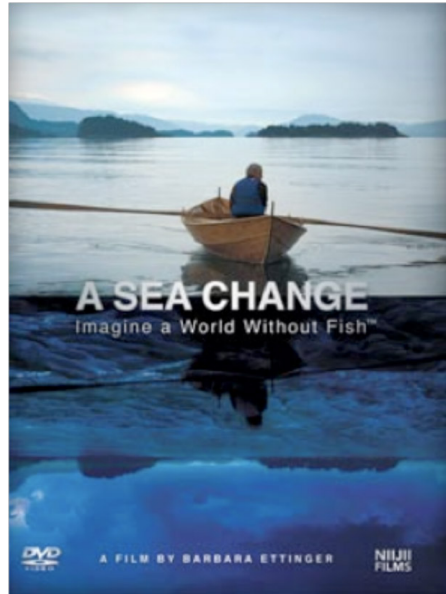


A SEA CHANGE
